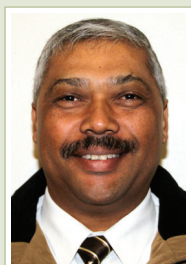

AREAPLAN: WYKE 5 & 6

Area-gebaseerde beplanning is 'n inisiatief wat die oorhoofse GOP-proses komplementeer deur te fokus op gemeenskappe. Gemeenskappe in hierdie konteks word verteenwoordig deur nedersettings (dorpe en wyke).

Swartland decided to take an approach that in the first place focuses on sensible geographical areas, simultaneously considering wards so that ward planning is not neglected. To achieve this, a number of wards are combined for each area plan to echo the area-based approach in a pragmatic way.

Die Munisipaliteit in samewerking met die wykskomitees het begin met die samestelling van die areaplanne wat al 12 wyke dek. Verskeie vergaderings was gehou met al 12 wyke om hulle kwessies en 5 top prioriteite te bepaal.

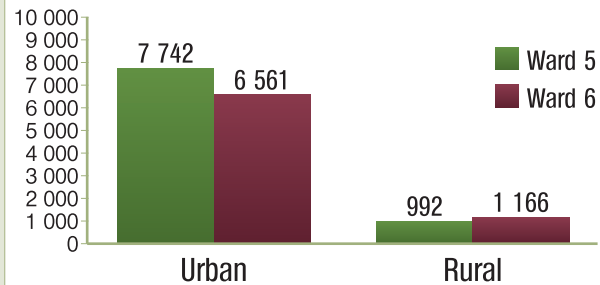

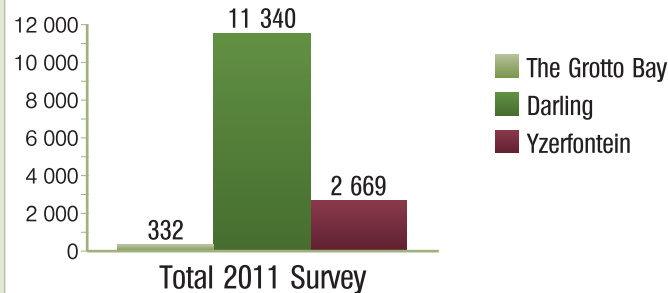
DEMOGRAFIESE OPNAME, 2011

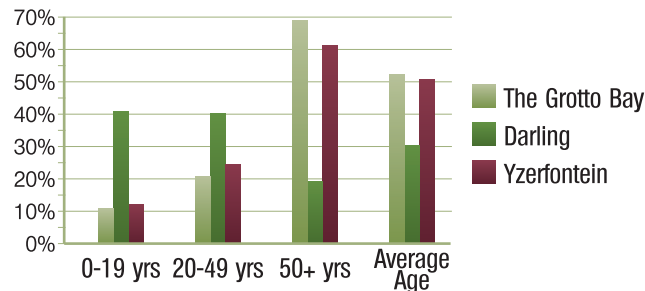
Population of Swartland Municipality by Ward (2011)
