

## **Jeugkamp in Duitsland 12 – 23 Julie 2025 : Geleentheid vir skole in die Swartland**

Swartland Munisipaliteit bied 'n geleentheid vir 10 hoërskoolleerders tussen 14 en 15 jaar om 'n kultuurkamp in Duitsland by te woon.

Aansoekvorms is by die skole beskikbaar en moet volledig voltooi en terugbesorg word aan Ilse Look van die Swartland Munisipaliteit op Malmesbury. Aansoekvorm word ook hierby ingesluit.

Leerders moet SA Burgers wees en hul ouers of voogde moet binne bereik wees om nodige vorms te teken. Leerders moet in besit van ID dokumente wees om aansoek te kan doen vir 'n paspoort. Leerders moet op eie onkoste aansoek doen vir paspoorte en "unabridged sertifikate". Paspoorte moet geldig wees tot ten minste 6 maande na Julie 2025. Leerders moet Afrikaans of Engels goed kan praat.

Die hoofdoel van die kamp is om verhoudings tussen verskillende kulture te versterk, om leierskapvaardighede te ontwikkel, om die visie van die jeug te verbreed en om groter verantwoordelikheid teenoor mekaar te help ontwikkel. Verskeie besienswaardighede sal besoek word.

Koste beloop R20 000,00 per leerder en sluit in vliegtuigkaartjies, lughawebelasting, visumkoste, versekering & medies, trein- en buskaartjies, verblyf, alle etes en reënbaadjie met logo. Koste kan verander, afhangend van die wisselkoers.

## **Youth camp in Germany 12 – 23 July 2025 : Opportunity for schools in the Swartland**

Swartland Municipality offers an opportunity for 10 high school students between the ages of 14 and 15 years to attend a cultural camp in Germany.

Application forms are available at the schools and must be completed in full and returned to Ilse Look at Swartland Municipality at Malmesbury. Application form is also enclosed herewith.

Learners must be SA Citizens and their parents or guardians must be within reach to sign necessary forms. Learners must be in possession of ID documents to be able to apply for a passport. Learners must apply for passports and "unabridged certificates" at their own expense. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months after July 2025. Learners must be able to speak Afrikaans or English well.

The main aim of the camp is to strengthen relations between different cultures, to develop leadership skills, to broaden the vision of the youth and to help develop greater responsibility towards each other. Various attractions will be visited.

Costs amount to R20 000.00 per learner and include flight tickets, airport tax, visa costs, insurance & medical, train and bus tickets, accommodation, all meals and rain jacket with logo. Costs may change depending on the exchange rate.
