# PROPOSED CONSOLIDATION OF ERF 6519 AND ERF 4128, MOORREESBURG

Your application with reference number 273~4128~Mrb, dated 30 July 2024, on behalf of Southern Oil Pty Ltd, refers.

By virtue of the authority delegated to the Senior Manager: Development Management, in terms of Council Decision No. 4.1 dated 28 March 2019, as determined by Section 79(1) of the Swartland Municipality: Municipal Land Use Planning By-Law (PG 8226 of 25 March 2020), the application for consolidation of Erf 6519 and Erf 4128, Moorreesburg, is approved in terms of Section 70 of the By-Law subject to the conditions that:

# TOWN PLANNING AND BUILDING CONTROL

- Erf 6519 (10 543m² in extent) be consolidated with Erf 4128 (2 955m² in extent) in order to create a new erf of 13 498m2 in extent;
- The owner/developer submits a general plan or diagram to the Surveyor-General for approval, including proof to the satisfaction of the Surveyor-General of
  - the municipality's decision to approve the consolidation;
  - the conditions of approval imposed in terms of section 76; and b.
  - the approved consolidation plan;

## WATER

The consolidated property be provided with a single water connection and that no additional connections be provided;

#### 2. **SEWERAGE**

The consolidated property be provided with a single sewerage connection and that no additional connections be provided;

## 3. STORM WATER

- a) The existing storm water pipe that crosses the boundary between Erf 6519 and Erf 4128, be surveyed and protected by the creation of a 4m wide servitude;
- b) The costs incurred by the survey and registration of the servitude be for the account of the owner/developer;

## 4. GENERAL

- a) The approval is valid for a period of 5 years, in terms of section 76(2) of the By-Law from date of decision. Should an appeal be lodged, the 5 year validity period starts from the date of outcome of the decision on the appeal;
- b) All conditions of approval be implemented in order for the consolidation to vest. Failing to comply will cause the approval to lapse. Should all conditions of approval be met within the 5 year period, the consolidation becomes permanent and the approval period will no longer be applicable.
