COMMUNITY BASED COLLECTION OF GENERAL SOLID WASTE AT CHATSWORTH, RIVERLANDS AND KALBASKRAAL FOR THE PERIOD ENDING 30 JUNE 2029

Swartland Municipality invites tenders for the supply of **Community Based Collection of General Solid Waste at Chatsworth, Riverlands and Kalbaskraal for the Period Ending 30 June 2029** for the towns of Chatsworth, Riverlands and Kalbaskraal in the Swartland Municipal Area, Western Cape.

The tender document will **not be available in electronic format**. A hard copy can be obtained at a non-refundable cash fee of **R180.00**. The fee is payable at the cashier offices at the Municipal offices in Hill Street Malmesbury. A hard copy of the document can be obtained from the reception at the engineering offices in Piet Retief Street, Malmesbury after payment has been made and upon producing proof of payment. **The document will be available from 23 February 2026 and can be collected during normal office hours at the Engineering Offices, PEP Building, Piet Retief Street Malmesbury.**

A compulsory clarification meeting will be held on **Wednesday, 4 March 2026 at 10:00 at the Banquet Hall, Municipal Head Offices, on the corner of Kerk- and Voortrekker Streets, Malmesbury.**

Quotations and all relevant documentation in a sealed envelope, clearly marked “**Tender T29.25.26 – “COMMUNITY BASED COLLECTION OF GENERAL SOLID WASTE AT CHATSWORTH, RIVERLANDS AND KALBASKRAAL”** must be deposited in the tender box at the Municipal Head Offices, on the cnr of Kerk and Voortrekker Street Malmesbury, before **12h00 on Friday, 27 March 2026**. No late quotations, electronic or faxed tenders will be accepted.

Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the Council’s Preferential Procurement Policy and the attached specifications. The 80/20-preference point system will be used for the evaluation of the contract. The Preferential Procurement Policy will be available for perusal during normal office hours at the municipal offices. The Swartland Municipality endorses and supports the Government’s Black Economic Empowerment Programme and is committed to rectify the inequalities of the past. For bidders to qualify for the advantages of the B-BBEE Act, they must thoroughly complete the attached Annexure MBD 6.1. **There will be no benefits if the schedule is not thoroughly completed. Preference points MUST also be claimed in paragraph 6.1.** Bidders are required to submit **original and valid B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates or certified copies** thereof together with their bids, to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims. **Bidders are also required to submit Proof of Locality in order to claim points for locality.** This Bid is subject to the General Conditions of Tender and if applicable, any other Special Conditions of Tender.
